

Aberfeldy textured scarf - design 1

Required: 200g Stylecraft Alpaca Tweed double knitting yarn; 4mm needles

Size: approx. 8 inches x 56 inches



Scarf:

Using 4mm needles, cast on 47 stitches.

Knit 2 rows.

1. slip 1, *(**purl 1, knit 4**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1
2. slip 1, *(**purl 3, knit 2**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1
3. slip 1, *(**purl 3, knit 2**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1
4. slip 1, *(**purl 1, knit 4**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1
5. slip 1, *(**knit 1, purl 4**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1
6. slip 1, *(**knit 3, purl 2**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1
7. slip 1, *(**knit 3, purl 2**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1
8. slip 1, *(**knit 1, purl 4**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1

Repeat the last 8 rows until the scarf is at your required length.

Knit 2 rows.

Cast off loosely.



Flower

Required: oddments of double knitting yarn in 3 colours; 3mm needles; brooch pin



Using dark grey, cast on 5 stitches.

- (knit 1, yarn forward, knit 1) in each stitch - 15 stitches
- purl
- *[knit in the front and back of first stitch, (*in the next stitch*: knit 1, yarn forward, knit 1, yarn forward, knit 1 then turn and purl 5, turn and knit 5, slip 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th stitch over the first stitch - this will make a bobble), knit into front and back of next stitch] repeat from * 5 times - 25 stitches
- (purl 1 beige, 3 grey, 1 beige) 5 times
- cut grey yarn

First petal:

- knit 1 pink, using beige knit into front and back of next 2 stitches, knit 1, knit 1 pink turn - 7 stitches
- purl 2 pink, using beige purl into front and back of next 2 stitches, purl 1, purl 2 pink - 9 stitches
- using pink knit into front and back of first stitch, knit 2, (knit 1 beige, knit 1 pink) twice, knit into front & back of next stitch, knit 1 - 11 stitches
- *continue with pink*: purl into front & back of first stitch, purl 8, purl into front & back of next stitch, purl 1 - 13 stitches
- knit 1, *(knit into front & back of stitch, knit 2) repeat from * 4 times - 17 stitches
- starting with a purl row, work 5 rows of stocking stitch
- knit 2 together through the back of the stitches on first 4 stitches, knit 9, knit 2 together twice - 13 stitches
- purl
- knit 1, knit 2 together through the back of the stitches, knit 7, knit 2 together, knit 1 - 11 stitches
- purl
- knit 1, knit 2 together through the back of the stitches, knit 1, slip 2 stitches, knit 1, pass slipped stitches over, knit 1, knit 2 together, knit 1 - 7 stitches
- cast off purling 2 together at the beginning and end of row

With right side facing work 4 more petals on each of 5 stitches.

Join row ends at the centre and gather cast on row. Work a few running stitches around each bobble and pull up firmly.

Sew a brooch pin onto the wrong side.

Aberfeldy textured scarf - design 2

Required: 50g Rowan Kidsilk haze stripe; 5mm needles & 4.5mm needles; thin elastic

Size: approx. 9 inches x 66 inches

Scarf:

Using 5mm needles, cast on 52 stitches.

Knit 2 rows.

1. knit 1, *(**purl 1, knit 4**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1 to end
2. knit 1, *(**purl 3, knit 2**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1 to end
3. knit 1, *(**purl 3, knit 2**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1 to end
4. knit 1, *(**purl 1, knit 4**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1 to end
5. knit 1, *(**knit 1, purl 4**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1 to end
6. knit 1, *(**knit 3, purl 2**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1 to end
7. knit 1, *(**knit 3, purl 2**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1 to end
8. knit 1, *(**knit 1, purl 4**) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1 to end

Repeat the last 8 rows until the yarn is nearly used up.

Save a little for the decorative band.

Knit 2 rows.

Cast off loosely.

Decorative Band:

Using 4.5mm needles, cast on 50 stitches.

Knit 2 rows.

Stocking stitch 10 rows.

Knit 2 rows.

Cast off.

Join row ends. Sew some beads on the front to decorate. Run some rows of thin elastic around the wrong side and pull in slightly (just enough to hold the scarf in place.)
