

Dog blanket using up oddments of yarn



Required: 350g double knitting yarn; 12mm needles
Size: 24 inches x 24 inches

Using 4 strands of yarn together and 12mm needles, cast on 50 stitches.

- slip 1, *(purl 1, knit 1) repeat from * to last stitch, purl 1
- slip 1 *(knit 1, purl 1) repeat from * to last stitch, knit 1

Repeat the above 2 rows 3 more times.

- slip 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit to last 5 stitches, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1

- slip 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl to last 5 stitches, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1

Repeat the above 2 rows 3 more times.

Start the motif on the next row by positioning it centrally and continuing in the above manner with the moss stitch border and the stocking stitch middle.

When the dog's head is completed, repeat the rows between # and # .

Repeat the first 8 rows (moss stitch) then cast off in pattern.

Darn in any stray yarn

The blanket can be lined if wanted.
