

Isle of Skye Celtic spiral necklace



Required: Oddment of Merino Roving Super chunky yarn bought from the Handspinner Having Fun on the Isle of Skye; 3 x 6mm needles

Method:

Using 6mm needles, cast on 28 stitches.

Put another needle on top of the needle in the left hand and cast on a further 28 stitches over both the needles.

Pull out the second needle so that you now have 56 stitches where the last 28 stitches are larger than the first 28 stitches.

Next row: Knit into the front, back and front again of 28 stitches then knit to the end of the row.

Cast off purl-wise. Twist one half into a spiral.

Make another piece the same.

Stitch the 2 pieces together.

Place around the neck and twist the top of the 2 spirals together.
