

Peg bag using up oddments of yarn

Be eco-friendly – use up your leftover yarn and dry your washing outdoors.

Yarn required: Approximately 150g of double knitting or a mixture of double knitting and 4 ply yarn.

Needles: 6mm

Wooden coat hanger – cut to size if necessary.

Using 3 lengths of yarn and 6mm needles cast on 40 stitches.

Work 4 rows of knit 1, purl 1 rib.

Then continue in stocking stitch until work measures about 21 inches.

Work 4 rows of knit 1, purl 1 rib.

Cast off rib-wise.

Darn in all the oddments of yarn. Turnover 2½ inches at the top – join row ends. Turn over the bottom so that the cast on edge is against the cast off edge. Join the row ends. Insert the coat hanger in the top part. Sew through back and front to secure the hanger.

Fill with pegs and do some washing!

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
