



## Snugfit for Toddlers

ridgy fabric, ear flaps and tie-strings make a real chillcheater for boys and girls

**MATERIALS** 1[2] oz. PATONS QUICKERNIT Baby Wool, Patonised. Two No. 9 BEEHIVE or QUEEN BEE needles. *You must use Quickerknit to be sure of a successful result.*

**MEASUREMENTS** Width round head 14 [16] ins.

**SIZES** The Figure in square brackets [ ] refers to the large size.

**TENSION** 6½ sts. and 8½ rows to one square inch on No. 9 needles, measured over stocking stitch. *See page 44 for how to check Tension and 42 for Abbreviations.*

### EAR PIECES (2)

Cast on 2 sts. **1st row**—Inc. in first st., K.1. **2nd and 4th rows**—P. **3rd row**—Inc. in each of first 2 sts., K.1. **5th row**—Inc. in first st., K. to last st., inc. in last st. **6th row**—P. Rep. 5th and 6th rows 5 [6] times more, then 5th row once (19 [21] sts.). Break off wool, slip sts. on to length of wool and leave.

### MAIN PART

Cast on 11 [13] sts., slip first group of 19 [21] sts. on to empty needle, P. across these sts., cast on 31 [35] sts., P. across second group of 19 [21] sts., **finally** cast on 11 [13] sts. (91 [103] sts.). Proceed in **ridge patt.** on all sts. as follows:

**1st row**—K. **2nd row**—P.

**3rd row**—P. **4th row**—K.

These 4 rows form the patt.

Continue in patt. until work measures 3½ [4] ins. from where groups of sts. were cast on, finishing with 4th row of patt.

**Shape top** as follows:

**1st row**—\* K.8, K.2 tog., rep. from \* to last 1 [3] sts., K.1 [3].

**2nd and every alt. row**—K.1, P. to last st., K.1.

**3rd row**—\* K.7, K.2 tog., rep. from \* to last 1 [3] sts., K.1 [3].

Continue dec. in this manner on every alt. row until 19 [23] sts. remain.

Thread wool through these sts. and fasten off securely.

### BORDER

With right side of work facing, **knit up** 11 [13] sts. from cast-on sts., 15 [17] sts. along one side of ear piece, 15 [17] sts. along other side of ear piece, 31 [35] sts. from cast-on sts., 15 [17] sts. from first side of second ear piece, 15 [17] sts. from 2nd side of ear piece, finally 11 [13] sts. (113 [129] sts.). **1st row**—K.

**2nd row**—P. Cast off knitwise.

### TO MAKE UP

Press very lightly on wrong side using a warm iron and damp cloth. Using a flat seam join seam. Using 6 strands of wool 34 ins. long make a twisted cord and attach to ear piece. Attach a small tassel to end of cord. Complete other side to match. Press seam.
