

Isle of Uist Neck warmer

Required: 50g unusual yarn - I used Handspun fine Merino double knitting yarn - dyed and spun on the Isle of Uist - the colour inspired by Uist Landscapes and called Atlantic. I bought it from the Hebridean Woolshed, Isle of South Uist.



Main Part:

Using 3.75mm needles, cast on 22 stitches.

- (knit 1, purl 1) to end of row
- (purl1, knit 1) to end of row

Continue in this manner until your work measures 20 inches.
Cast off loosely. Join the cast on and cast off edges neatly.

Middle Part:

Using 3.75mm needles, cast on 10 stitches.

- (knit 1, purl 1) to end of row
- (purl1, knit 1) to end of row

Continue in this manner until your work measures 4½ inches.
Cast off loosely. Wrap around the join on the main part and sew cast on edge to cast off edge.
