

Celtic Spiral Necklace



Required: 50g unusual yarn - I used Handspun fine Merino double knitting yarn - dyed and spun on the Isle of Uist - the colour inspired by Uist Landscapes and called Atlantic. I bought it from the Hebridean Woolshed, Isle of South Uist.

Using 3.75mm needles, cast on 13 stitches.

1. (right side) knit 1, *slip 1 purlwise, knit 1, repeat from * to end.
2. Purl

Continue in this manner until the work measures 21 inches. Cast off.

Join cast off & cast on edges - allow to curl naturally.

Spiral decorations:

Using 6mm needles, cast on 14 stitches.

Change to 3.75mm needles and knit into front, back and front again of every stitch to the end of the row.

Cast off purl wise.

Twist until it curls then sew onto band.

Make 6 others.
